KAWAZU SAKURA (or KAWAZU-ZAKURA) is one of the earliest-blooming cherry blossoms in Japan with pretty deep pink color petals. The original tree is at Kawazu-town in IZU peninsula, and in present, more than 8,000 cherry trees lined-up along river to make the festival site brightly! (<http://www.kawazu-onsen.com/eng/sakura/>) TSURUSHI-KAZARI is of great interest a custom in the Inatori district since Edo Period that hanging decorations originally made of colorful KIMONO cloths. It was originally the gift for new born girls (http://www.mustlovejapan.com/subject/tsurushi_kazari/). We could visit the exhibition site of those to enjoy local traditional craftworks! Visit Joren Waterfall which drops in to a pristine virgin forest (http://www.mustlovejapan.com/subject/joren_fall/). Before come back to Yokosuka, sweeten up your mouth by strawberries that all-you-can eat sweet strawberries for 30 minutes (not for take-out)!
