DESCRIPTION:

Nagano - it is treasure-house of nature, history and culture. And, is surrounded on all for sides by higher chain mountains (Japan Alps), earning it the nickname of the "Roof of Japan". On this tour, we will take you to the popular sightseeing spots in Nagano for a rare experience.

Day 1:

Zenko-ji Temple - The temple has the biggest wooden main hall in East Japan and over 300 years old after it was re-constructed. Over seven million people will visit every year because the temple has not belonged to any Buddhist sect and has been widely popular among all walks of people (<http://www.zenkoji.jp/ENGLISH/about/index.html>).

You also could experience Japanese style lodging/meals and Taiko drum performance at the hotel.

Day 2:

Snow Monkey Park - It is located at Jigoku-dani valley. This may be the only place in the world where wild snow monkeys can be seen bathing in the natural hot spring water. There are approximately 270 wild snow monkeys inhabited in the park. At 2,834 feet in elevation, it is a harsh environment where snow covers the ground for one-third of the year, and this place is a paradise for monkeys (http://www.jigokudani-yaenkoen.co.jp/english/html/top_e.htm).

Matsumoto Castle - Located right in the center of Nagano prefecture, Matsumoto city. Originally built in 1504, the existing five-story castle tower is the oldest in Japan and considered a national treasure. The outside walls of the castle tower are black, earning the place the nickname of Karasu-jo, or Crow Castle. Inside the castle is a museum exhibiting a collection of Japanese matchlocks and samurai armor dating from the mid-16th century through the Edo Period (<http://myoko-nagano.com/matsumoto-castle/>). Don't forget to bring a camera on this tour!
