DESCRIPTION:

Come and join this memorable tour in Fukushima Prefecture. Our first visit on this tour will be Aizu-mura Japanese Garden. This beautiful garden consists three-story pagoda, a sleeping Buddha statue and one hundred and ninety feet high standing Kannon means goddess of mercy and the mother of all beings. We are sure that you will spend relaxing and memorable time at this garden (<http://bit.ly/AzmuraV>). Next we will take you to Tsuruga castle. Originally built in 1384, the city flourished as a center of warrior culture. The castle was destroyed soon after the collapse of the Tokugawa shogunate. The existing main donjon, a reconstruction undertaken in 1965, houses a Folklore Museum with nationally designated Important Cultural Properties and other historical materials on display (<http://www.tsurugajo.com/language/eng/index.html>). Last stop of this tour will be Aizu Samurai residence, Nestled on the outskirts of Aizu Wakamatsu city within view of Tsuruga Castle, the massive grounds house many of the structures that were once used in the daily life of Saigo Tanomo Chikanori, one of the chief retainers for the Matsudaira family. The huge compound shows the wealth and importance the high-ranking samurai once held (<http://bit.ly/ABukeY>).
