

NIKKO AUTUMN SAMURAI COSTUME PARADE

DESCRIPTION:

Nikko, one of Japan's most popular tourist spots, is holding its annual Samurai Festival. While there, experience how Japanese people celebrate traditional festivals. The main festival site is Nikko Toshogu Shrine. It is one of the few remaining architectural wonders of the world. This national treasure, dedicated to the first Shogun (Lord) of the Tokugawa regime in the early 17th century, is visited by millions of tourists who come to admire the ornate and expensive architectural structures within the temple grounds. These include a five-storied Pagoda, a sacred stable and a sacred stone house. Then we experience the Samurai Costume Parade Festival. We watch hundreds of Japanese people dressed in imitation of Samurai armor and other costumes of the Tokugawa era, form a multicolored processional along a traditional shrine route. This festival is a must-see for those who want to experience Japanese culture (<http://bit.ly/NKSCP>). Before leave the area, offer another enjoyment that boat ride on the Kinugawa River. Walk down one hundred steps for the riverboat ride which six-kilometer distance with forty-minutes boat ride takes us through breathtaking scenery that includes beautiful foliage, intriguing rock formations and an expansive panorama of the beautiful gorge carved by Mother Nature herself (<http://travel.tochigiji.or.jp/en/things-to-do/15/>).
