DESCRIPTION:

Izu peninsula is a resort area about 70 km southwest of Yokosuka, popular for its hot springs, beautiful coastlines, beaches, mild climate and scenic mountainous interior (http://bit.ly/cmlxgY).

Day 1:

Usami Kannon - which has a scenic temple ground with the biggest sitting Kannon - Goddess of Mercy in Japan. The other god's statues as Shichifukujin (seven gods for good luck), 33 of Kannon goddess statues and unique architecture style of temple gate will welcome you (http://bit.ly/9P9NLQ). **Jogasaki Nature Trail** - Jogasaki Cliff is at the east part of Izu peninsula, has 2 miles long nature trail on the deeply-indented coastline. It serves you a great view of Pacific Ocean and incredible thrill by a suspension bridge has 77 feet high with 160 feet length! (http://bit.ly/JOGAHIKE). Available to enter Izu SHIKI NO HANA Park at arrival point of Nature trail, you will have a chance to meet beautiful Hydrangeas (http://bit.ly/IzuHyd).

Izu Imaihama Tokyu Resort - The hotel is located Imaihama beachside and all rooms has ocean view. It definitely gives you a romantic mood and satisfaction with delicious meals.

Day 2:

Hagachizaki Monkey Park – it is located at edge of the peninsula. About 300 of wild monkeys are inhibited and show us their funny face & action (http://bit.ly/IZUMONKEY).

Dogashima Marine – will be an exciting twenty-minute marine cave cruise that provides us outstanding views of tall cliffs and tiny islands weathered by strong winds and rough seas. Tensodo Cave and Sanshirojima Island can also be seen. The cruise is truly an experience that highlights the mysteries of Mother Nature (http://www.izudougasima-yuransen.com/en/index.html).

Toi Gold Mine - Discovered in 1370, this mine was under the direct control of the Ashikaga Shogunate for many years. The gold mine, which closed when the gold was exhausted, was later turned into a tourist gallery. Sections of the old tunnels, fitted with miners-at-work mannequins, provide visitors with a visual trip back to yesteryear Japan. An on-site gold mine museum boasts a display of the world's largest gold bar, worth 230 million yen. At the last, you could experience gold panning (http://izu-sakuraya.jp/english/travelinfo/toigoldmine/index.htm).
