DESCRIPTION:

The Snow Monkey Park (Yaen Koen) is located in the picturesque Jigoku-dani valley in Nagano prefecture. Among the snowy mountains and steaming onsen dwell the wild Japanese Macaques, more commonly known as Snow Monkeys. These remarkable creatures find refuge from the severe cold and rugged forest of the area by dipping in to natural hot springs. If you've ever seen a documentary or photos of monkeys in hot springs, chances are they were taken here as this may be the only place in the world where this occurs. At 2,834 feet in elevation and harsh environment where snow covers the ground for one-third of the year, this place is a virtual paradise for the close to 300 monkeys in the park (http://www.jigokudani-yaenkoen.co.jp/english/html/top_e.htm). Before it, we will visit Matsumoto Castle. Located in the center of Nagano prefecture and surrounded by the Japan Alps this castle's origins date back to 1504 when it first existed as Fukushima Castle, has been designated as a national treasure and regarded as one of the most beautiful castles in Japan. It boasts the oldest structure of its kind in the country and its striking black castle walls has earned it the nickname of Karasu-jo, or Crow Castle. Inside the castle is a museum exhibiting a collection of Japanese matchlocks and samurai armor dating from the 16th century to the Edo Period making it a perfect photo opportunity!
