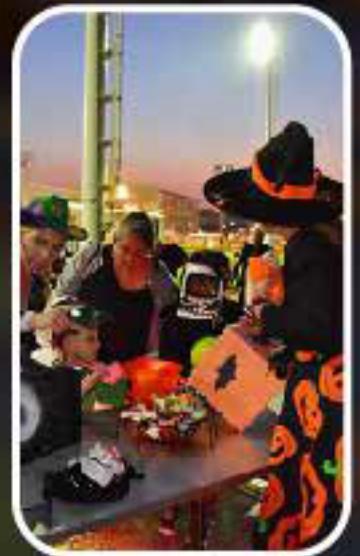

### Prerequisite 1:

Complete a swim-tread-swim sequence without stopping to rest:

- Jump into the water and totally submerge, resurface then swim 150 yards using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both. (Swimming on the back or side is not permitted. Swim goggles are allowed).
- Tread water for 2 minutes using legs only.
- Swim 50 yards using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both.

### Prerequisite 2:

Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds:

- Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. (The face may be in or out of the water. Swim goggles are not allowed.)
- Surface dive (feet-first or head-first) to a depth of 7 - 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object.
- Return to the surface and swim 20 yards on your back to return to the starting point, holding the object at the surface with both hands and keeping your face at or near the surface.
- Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.

## Family Child Care (FCC) Information for Parents

Family Child Care (FCC) offers quality care in a loving, learning home environment for children ages six weeks to twelve years. All homes are certified by DoD.

FCC providers are encouraged to obtain accreditation by the National Association for Family Child Care (NAFCC). As an additional quality assurance measure, FCC providers receive a minimum of one unannounced monitoring visit each month to assess providers' relationships with children and families, appropriateness of the learning environment, planned activities, safety and health of the home, and other items. The goal of these visits is to provide programmatic support and ensure adherence to Navy standards and policies.

### Parent Fees

All FCC subsidized rates must be verified during initial registration using Total Family Income (TFI), and updated annually. TFI will be verified by documentation to include spouse's most recent LES(s), W-2 forms, or detailed pay information. Students are required to provide proof of full-time school enrollment.

- Eligible patrons include: Active Service Members / DoD Civilians.
- Parent fee is assessed through established income categories.
- Multi-child discount will be applied to additional child enrolled.
- Hourly fees will be discussed with your FCC provider.

## Family Care Plan Campaign

The Child Development Centers, Child Development Homes, and the School Age Centers will be reaching out to military families to ensure the Family Care Plans are completed. Child & Youth Programs will work with families and their command to ensure all active duty single and dual military families with dependents enrolled in CDC or SAC programs have the correct paperwork completed and turned in for this requirement.

### What is the Family Care Plan?

Family Care Plans are mission planning tools to establish and document written plans to care for minor children while the sailor is absent (DoD Instruction 1342.19).

### Who does it affect?

The Family Care Plan (FCP) is required for all single and dual active duty military sailors with children enrolled in CDC or SAC programs.

### When does the FCP need to be completed?

Single and dual sailors with dependents enrolled in CDC or SAC programs are asked to complete the FCP as soon as possible. New enrollments have up to 60 days from the original start date to provide FCP.

### Why is it important?

To be mission ready and best prepared to take care of your child in case of an emergency.

### What can you do?

Contact CYP as soon as possible to verify your FCP status.

**Note:** As each state has different requirements, there is no guarantee that a stateside drivers' license can be obtained by presenting the certificate of completion to a state Department of Motor Vehicles. 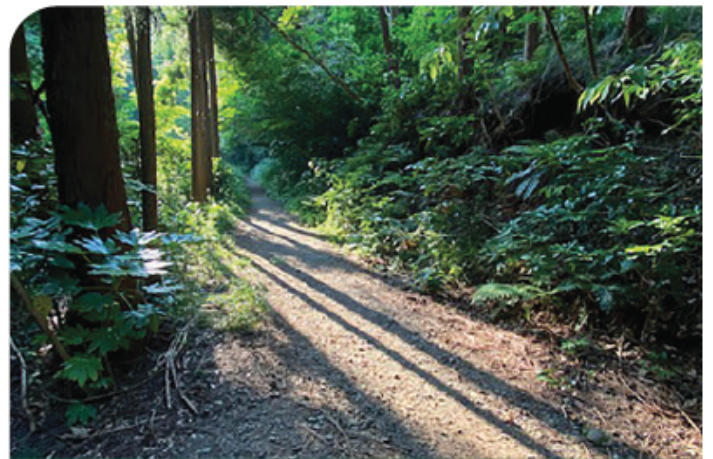

## **Extreme Onsen and Hiking with Ouchijyuku Post Town Visit** *Sunday, October 20 • 4 a.m. - 8 p.m.*

The trip begins with a stop at Ouchijyuku Post Town, an Edo Period town with thatched roof buildings housing gift shops. 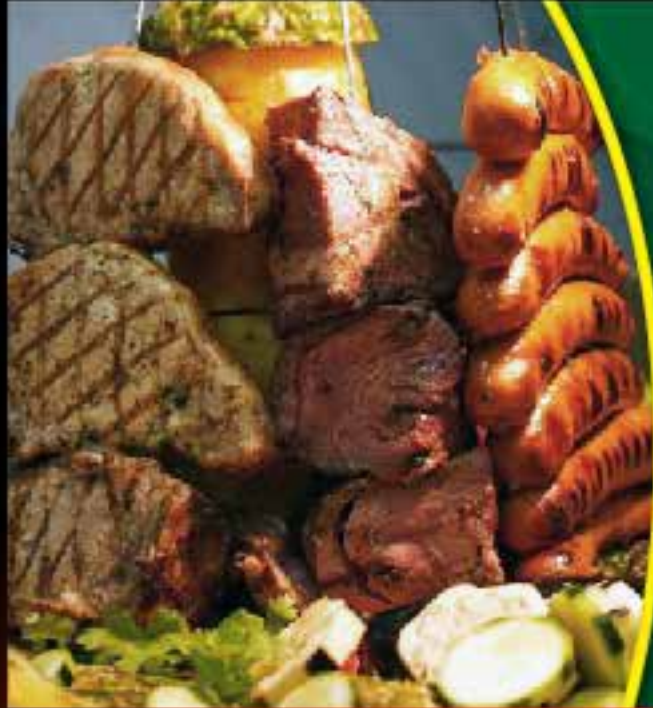

- Swim 50 yards using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both.

Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds:


- Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. (The face may be in or out of the water. Swim goggles are not allowed.)
- Surface dive (feet-first or head-first) to a depth of 7 - 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object.
- Return to the surface and swim 20 yards on your back to return to the starting point, holding the object at the surface with both hands and keeping your face at or near the surface.
- Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.

## Family Child Care (FCC) Information for Parents

Family Child Care (FCC) offers quality care in a loving, learning home environment for children ages six weeks to twelve years. All homes are certified by DoD.

FCC providers are encouraged to obtain accreditation by the National Association for Family Child Care (NAFCC). As an additional quality assurance measure, FCC providers receive a minimum of one unannounced monitoring visit each month to assess providers' relationships with children and families, appropriateness of the learning environment, planned activities, safety and health of the home, and other items. The goal of these visits is to provide programmatic support and ensure adherence to Navy standards and policies.

### Parent Fees

All FCC subsidized rates must be verified during initial registration using Total Family Income (TFI), and updated annually. TFI will be verified by documentation to include spouse's most recent LES(s), W-2 forms, or detailed pay information. Students are required to provide proof of full-time school enrollment.

- Eligible patrons include: Active Service Members / DoD Civilians.
- Parent fee is assessed through established income categories.
- Multi-child discount will be applied to additional child enrolled.
- Hourly fees will be discussed with your FCC provider.

## Family Care Plan Campaign

The Child Development Centers, Child Development Homes, and the School Age Centers will be reaching out to military families to ensure the Family Care Plans are completed. Child & Youth Programs will work with families and their command to ensure all active duty single and dual military families with dependents enrolled in CDC or SAC programs have the correct paperwork completed and turned in for this requirement.

### What is the Family Care Plan?

Family Care Plans are mission planning tools to establish and document written plans to care for minor children while the sailor is absent (DoD Instruction 1342.19).

### Who does it affect?

The Family Care Plan (FCP) is required for all single and dual active duty military sailors with children enrolled in CDC or SAC programs.

### When does the FCP need to be completed?

Single and dual sailors with dependents enrolled in CDC or SAC programs are asked to complete the FCP as soon as possible. New enrollments have up to 60 days from the original start date to provide FCP.

### Why is it important?

To be mission ready and best prepared to take care of your child in case of an emergency.

### What can you do?

Contact CYP as soon as possible to verify your FCP status.

**Note:** As each state has different requirements, there is no guarantee that a stateside drivers' license can be obtained by presenting the certificate of completion to a state Department of Motor Vehicles. ## Red Snapper Deep Sea Fishing in Tokyo Bay Sunday, November 17 • 6 a.m. – 4 p.m.

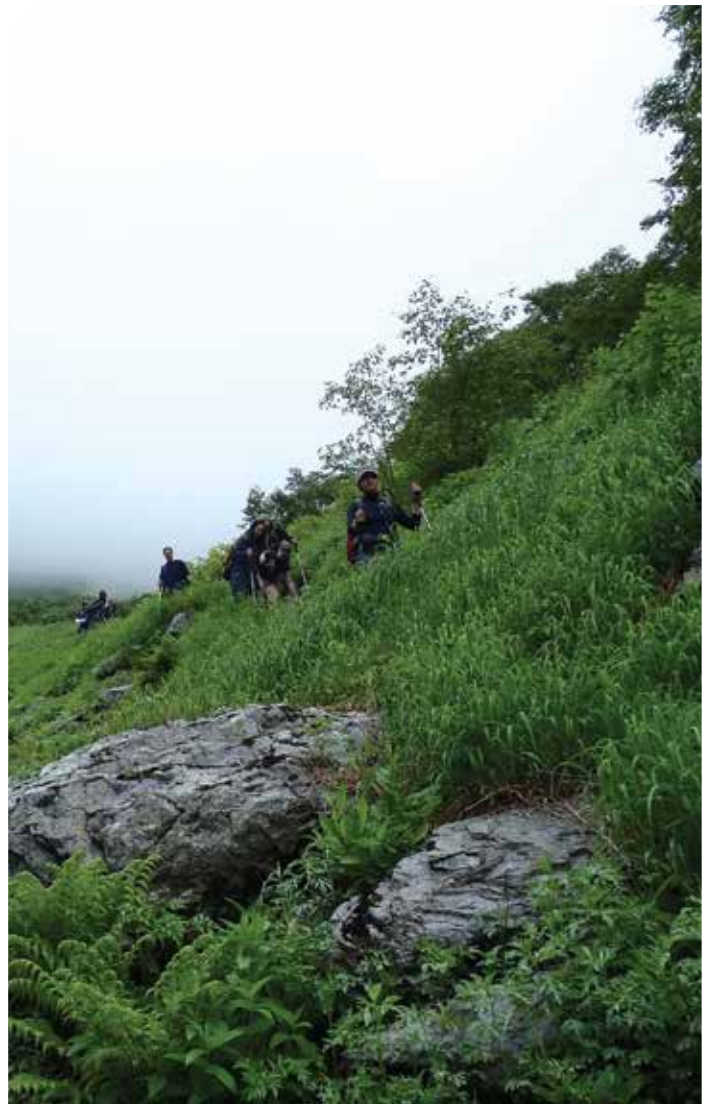
Our goal is to get you to the fish and make your fishing charter memorable. The boat will drive a couple of hours to fishing spots around Kurihama and Okinose by Chiba. Registration fee includes transportation, tackle, bait and an experienced sea captain to take you out for a day of sun, sea and fishing. Target fish is red snapper, but you may also catch rockfish and mackerel. Minimum age is 12 years old. **\$180 / person**

## Intermediate Trail Hike to Mitsumine Shrine (Blue Jacket) Saturday, November 23 • 5 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Mitsumine Shrine is a hidden gem atop Mt. Mitsumine meaning three peaks - in Chichibu Tama Kai National Park. This mountain sanctuary was originally formed by Yamato Takeru, the imperial dynasty's legendary prince, and has long been associated with mountain aestheticism. Nowadays, the area is reachable by driving, but we will hike up to the shrine with a 760m/2,493ft elevation gain. The trail stretches along the Arakawa Gorge with waterfalls, leading through dense cedar and cypress trees. At the top, Yohaiden Pavilion, a vibrant shrine complex protected by the unique Japanese-wolf warriors, offers a magnificent view of the surrounding mountains. Minimum age is 18 years old. **\$75 / person (Blue Jacket: \$55)**

## Long Distance Walk at Ashinoko, Hakone Thursday, November 28 • 6 a.m. – 5 p.m.

This 11 km (almost 7 miles!) walk along the west shore of Lake Ashi starts from the south end of the lake and ends at the north end where we will catch a boat back to the trailhead. The trip includes the cost of the boat ride. Minimum age is 10 years old. **\$60 / person**



## Intermediate Hike at Tanzawa Oyama (Blue Jacket) Saturday, November 30 • 5 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Known as the “Guardian of the Land,” Oyama in the Tanzawa Mountains has long been worshipped by the locals. If the weather allows, you may catch a glimpse of Mt. Fuji and shimmering ocean from the 4,100-ft summit. This five-hour/seven-mile hike passes several shrines and temples set amidst the forest. Minimum age is 10 years old. **\$50 / person (Blue Jacket: \$40)**



## Overnight Ski / Snowboard Trips 2-Day Nozawa Onsen Fire Festival Overnight Wednesday - Thursday, January 15 - 16 2:30 a.m. - 10 p.m.

Nozawa Onsen is a Japanese traditional hot spring resort from the Edo Period and strives to maintain its historic atmosphere. Nozawa's most famous festival, held on January 15th every year, is a must-see cultural experience. Here fire erupts in a designated area of the village where thousands gather to celebrate and pray for the wellbeing and good fortune of the village, and to ensure a plentiful harvest for the coming year. The fire festival is one of Japan's three most celebrated fire festivals, where torch bearing villagers battle against young men barricaded in a pre-built wooden fort with an aim to burn it down. Nozawa Onsen ski resort is gigantic with 20 courses supported by 22 lifts and 2 gondolas. It boasts Japan's longest ski course of 10km (6.2 miles). There are 13 public hot spring baths, free of charge in the village. Trip fee includes transportation, lodging at Chalet Nozawa / La Neige and breakfast. **Registration cut-off date is December 13.** Open to all ages. **\$220** / person for all ages



## 3-Day Shiga Kogen Ski / Snowboard Overnight with Wild Snow Monkey Park (optional) Saturday - Monday, January 18 - 20 • 2 a.m. - 10 p.m.

Shiga Kogen is the largest ski resort in Japan, offering 21 interlinked resorts with 71 lifts and gondolas all on one lift ticket! Snow conditions and quality are often superb. Yakibitaiyama resort is the most modern of all the resorts at Shiga Kogen and has 2 gondolas and 8 lifts which cover the huge terrain. Trip fee includes transportation, lodging at Shiga Kogen Prince Hotel, dinner and breakfast. MWR bus will provide a free shuttle to Wild Snow Monkey Park on January 19 (optional). **Registration cut-off date is December 26.** Open to all ages. **\$400** / adult (13 years and above), **\$360** / child (12 years and below), **\$535** / single room use occupancy for a twin room

Experience a journey to a remote and spiritual region of Japan. Hike an ancient mossy flagstone path lined with luscious ferns and cypress forest. The Kumano Kodo, meaning "Old Path to Kumano," is a network of pilgrimage trails that traverse the rugged mountains of the Kii Peninsula and is designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Kumano is considered a Buddhist pure land paradise and is the heart of the intersection with Buddhism, Shintoism and mountain worship.

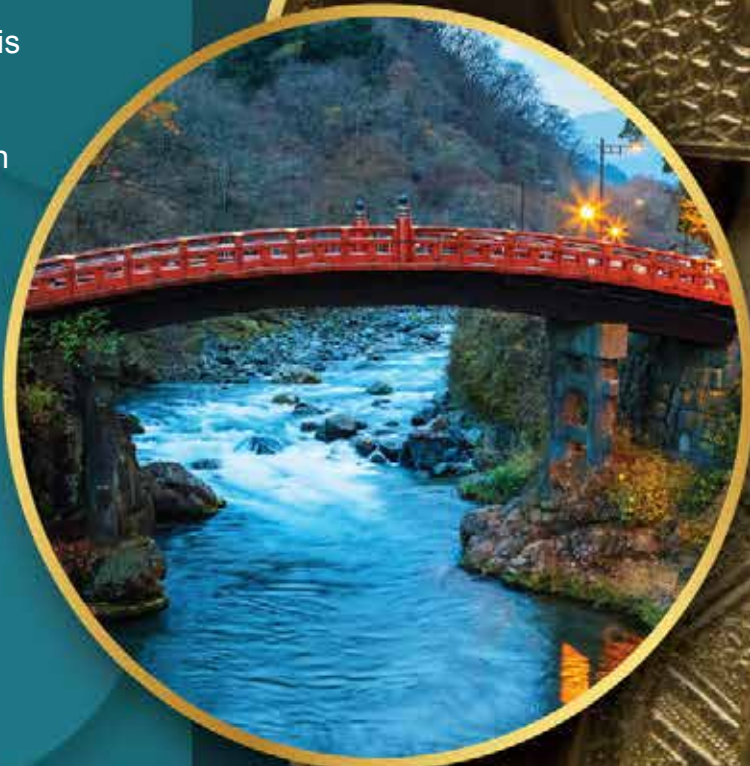

# NIKKO

Nikko is a small city in Japan's Tochigi Prefecture, in the mountains north of Tokyo. It's the site of Toshogu, the famed Shinto shrine established in 1617 as a memorial for Tokugawa Ieyasu.

Tokugawa Ieyasu was the founder and first shōgun of the Tokugawa shogunate of Japan, which ruled Japan from 1603 until the Meiji Restoration in 1868. He was one of the three "Great Unifiers" of Japan, along with his former lord Oda Nobunaga and fellow Oda subordinate Toyotomi Hideyoshi.
